#### **TECH INSPECTION:**

#### **GENERAL PADDOCK INFORMATION:**

**PARKING:** Detailed parking information will be shared as we get close to the event.

**TRACK ACCESS:** The Race Track is closed when the track is cold. Other than a sanctioned VRG track walk, no participant may access the track surface.

**BRIDGE:** The bridge into the paddock is weight limited to 5 tons per axle. Vehicles exceeding this weight limit must use the track crossing across from pit out.

**WRIST BANDS:** Track and VRG wrist bands must both remain on your wrist throughout the event.

**PIT WALL:** The pit wall is off limits to all spectators and crew.

**TRASH:** Cans are no longer located in paddock spots. Dumpsters are located in central areas of the paddock. Trash Bags will be available at registration.

**QUIET TIME:** Race car engines must not be operated between 7:00 pm and 7:00 am.

**DRONES:** Strictly prohibited.

**RACE SUPPORT VEHICLES:** Prohibited on the grid.

**FIREAMS: Firearms** are not permitted on the premises of the facility with the exception of firearms training courses and law enforcement personnel. Violators will be excused from the event without refund.

PETS: Pets allowed on leash and please clean up after your pet.

PERSONAL VEHICLES: ATV's, golf carts are allowed if used by adults at reasonable speed.

CAMPING: Camping is allowed with some electric hookups available, fee paid to the track.

FOOD SERVICE: "Chez Summit" cafeteria will be available throughout the event.

**GENERAL DIRECTIONS TO THE TRACK:**

From the north: I-81 to WV exit #5 / Inwood: Rt 51 east 5 miles to Middleway; right on Leetown Rd /Rt 1 south 5 miles to the village of Summit Point: right on Rt 13 to track

From the south: I-81 to Va exit #315, Winchester; right on Rt 7 east 7 miles to traffic signal; left on Rt632, follow to the "T" turn right onto Rt 761 to next "T" turn right, track is on the right.

From the east: Follow Rt 340 from Frederick Md. towards Charles Town WV (do not get on by-pass Rt340/ go straight into Charles Town, stay straight, after last traffic signal leaving Town stay straight, at stop sign bear slight left, follow signs straight to track
